### English:

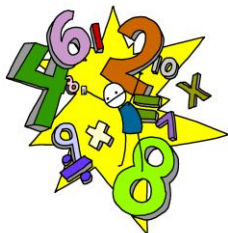
This week we are going to be focusing on using a full stop when writing sentences and introducing using a capital letter at the beginning of a sentence.
