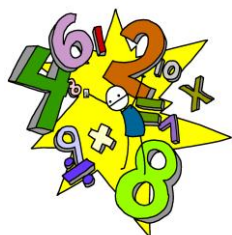
English:

Maths:

We will be exploring fractions this week. The children will be aiming to identify halves, quarters and thirds of shapes and objects and they will be looking to understand how each fraction is part of a whole.
