We will be visiting the Library on Wednesday morning to see Nick Arnold. He is the author of the Horrible Science books so I am sure that it will be both interesting and funny. Homework:

- Spelling: homophones. The children need to know the meanings of the words so that they can choose the correct spelling when I read a sentence containing the word.
- Maths: Abacus game online and TT Rockstars (minimum 10 garage games to be completed by Friday morning).
- English: Legend homework set last week and due in on 14th October; the children will be re-telling their legends during that week.
- Reading: daily reading sessions will be rewarded with golden points. They may choose to read from library books, magazines or non-fiction books in addition to their book from the reading scheme.

English: We will be writing a legend using the grammar we have built up over the last weeks including subordinate clauses and direct speech.

Maths:

We will be working on 3D shapes. We will be identifying and describing them in terms of their properties, eg curved or flat faces, number of edges and vertices etc and sorting them using Venn diagrams.

Brass:

The next lesson is on Friday. I will send home letters about borrowing the instruments today. If I have the reply slip by Friday I will send home the instrument after Friday's lesson but if you don't manage to do it this week it is not a problem, I will just send the instrument home when I get the slip.
